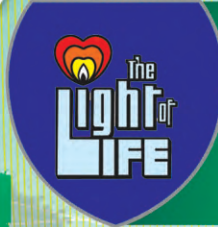

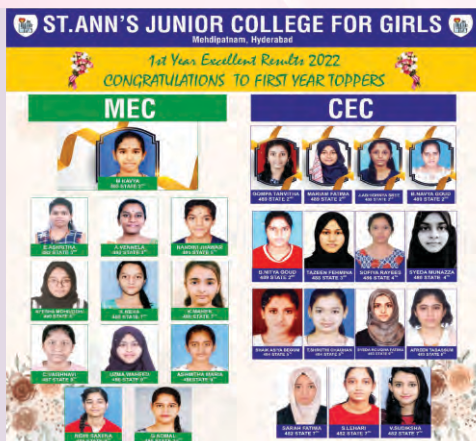


VI. Higher Education Highlights

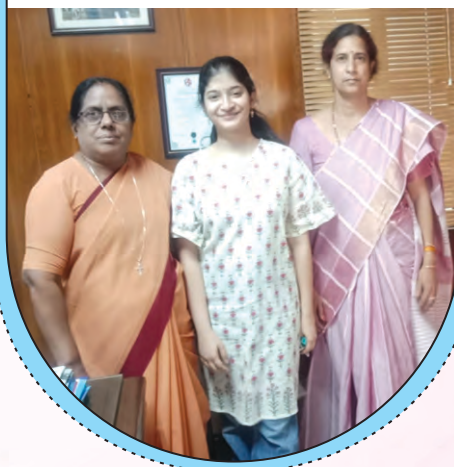

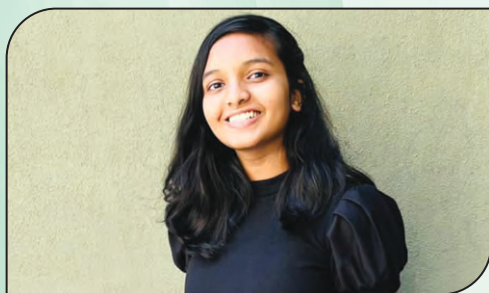

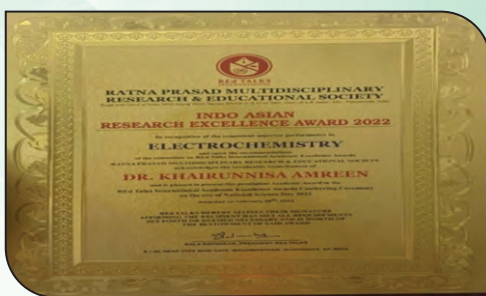
